The Hànyǔ Shuǐpíng Kǎoshì (HSK), translated as Chinese Proficiency Test, is China's only standardized test of Standard Chinese language proficiency for non-native speakers such as foreign students and overseas Chinese. The test is administered by Hanban, a non-government organization affiliated with the Ministry of Education of the People's Republic of China. The HSK test approximates the English TOEFL, and an HSK certificate is valid without any limitation in China. The test aims to be a certificate of language proficiency for higher educational and professional purposes. Each year HSK certificates are issued to those who meet required scores. In addition, test takers with outstanding results can win a scholarship for short-term language study in China.

Zhejiang University of Science & Technology began to hold the HSK in 2013. We offer a variety of levels of HSK annually like HSK3, HSK4, HSK5 and HSKK (Intermediate level).
